#### day 1: Siem Reap

Upon arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, meets and transfer our local guide to the hotel for check-in (Early check-in is NOT included and subject to the hotel's availability). Check-in at the hotel and free at leisure.

day 2: Siem Reap - Village Walking - Floating Community - Rolous Temple

Morning transfer out of the **Siem Reap** town to a beautiful village in the countryside, you will start to walk through the village houses, witness with very nice and different activities from the locals for



their daily life. Just as some examples: how the locals wash vehicles, selling gasoline in whiskey

bottles or the small shops where the locals sell food on the side of small streets.

Enjoy a view of this wonderful area and interact with very kindly people in the village, a 30-minute

old mean vehicle ox/buffalo-cart ride through the rice

paddies to reach at one big local house to see how this family doing daily work such as making rice wine and handicraft works meanwhile the member of the family will offer you of fresh coconut and some manmade rice wine to taste.

Continue with your guide for driving onward to the next destination, a floating community, arrive at

the quay for embarking on a motorized boat to visit floating houses village where offering an incredible natural phenomenon of making their lives from the lake in a respectful and meaningful way. This is a great chance to witness one of Cambodia and the world's most amazing natural wonders.



Lunch is hosted at the local family.

Continue to the ancient **Khmer** civilization site of **Hariharalaya** which flourished in the late 9th and earlier 10th centuries. These are the earliest temples in the Angkor area and are referred to the Rolous group we visit the main one called Bakhong temple.

Meals included: Breakfast/Lunch.

day 3: Temples of Siem Reap Angkor

After breakfast at around 08:00a.m, you will depart on a tethered helium 15 minute balloon flight



that will lead you 200 meters up for an amazing aerial view of **Angkor Wat** and other ruins amongst the surrounding jungle and rice paddies glimmering down below.

Drive to visit the intricately carved Khmer ruins at Angkor Wat - one of the world's most impressive ruins. The temple still owns fine Apsara carvings in Angkorian era art. visit the picturesque Ta Prohm that had nearly disappeared into the jungle and remains overgrown, an oddly haunting and exotic scene. The

magnificent roots of a tree, pushing between the huge stone blocks of the temple in a sort of embrace, evoke feelings that you may remember forever

After lunch (own account), continue to explore the mysterious **Royal city Angkor Thom City** & Bayon Its 54-tower temple is an awesome sight. At first glance it seems a shapeless mass of stone, but further scrutiny reveals a face, and then another and another until suddenly you are engulfed by the silent, heavy, enigmatic and silent gaze through half-closed eyes, staring out from a primitive and remote time. Further, visit to the surroundings of the complex including the





**Baphoun, Elephant Terraces, Lepper King Terrace** and **Royal Place** area. Evening, Enjoy dinner with *Apsara Dinner Show,* a traditional Khmer performance featuring dance and music.

Meals included: Breakfast/Dinner.



day 4: Siem Reap Battambang via terra

Transfer onwards to **Battambang** and check into your hotel upon arrival late afternoon. (Lunch is at Battamang. Enjoy bamboo train just before the sun goes down. **Battambang** is all about the arts scene as much as it is the typical sites and the architecture is quite simply stunning. Tonight you are recommended to visit Lotus Bar and Gallery or Bric a Brac for a glass of wine following by the dinner at Jaan Bai restaurant (own account). The menu was created by a Michelin Star chef who resides in Bangkok, Thailand.

Meals included: Breakfast.









day 5: Battambang in bicicletta

Spend your day exploring the countryside around Battambang on a bicycle visiting Cambodian families who produce traditional products (such as rice paper, dried bananas, bamboo sticky rice, and rice wine), made in the same way they have been for generations. You will learn first-hand about everyday life in rural communities which make up over 70% of Cambodia's population. Lunch is in town (own arrangement).

Visit to the well preserved 11th century Angkorian

temple of Prasat Phnom Banan, located atop a hill bearing the same name. After climbing the 350+

steps you are treated to a peaceful setting with superb views across the surrounding countryside.

End of the day with a visit to Phnom Sampeau, which is a massive limestone outcrop that is dissected by a number of caves of which some are more accessible than others. Some caves contain unexpected reminders of Cambodia's turbulent history. Every evening at nightfall, thousands of bats make their way out of caves in the hillside to feed before returning at dawn. This natural phenomenon really is a "must see" for the visitor.

day 6: Battambang - Kampong Chnnang - Phnom Penh

Bid farewell to **Battambang** and drive 3 hours further southeast to the seldom visited Kampong Chnnang, well known for its fine clay pottery. The name of the province says it all in **Khmer**;



**Kampong Chhnang** means "Port of Pottery". The people of this province enjoy making pots, vases and various others types of ceramics during the off harvest seasons.

Learn how the community makes pottery the traditional way and observe how sugar is collected from the sugar palm trees. Let your guide assist you with translating if you are interested to learn more about village life.

Continue to **Kampong Luong which** is a silversmith village. Observe silversmiths creating ornate and

fashionable silver objects. Arrive into your hotel, check in and remain of the day is free at your own leisure.

Meals included: Breakfast







#### day 7: Tour della città di Phnom Penh

The capital city of **Phnom Penh** was once considered the loveliest city of Indochina. Despite its recent turbulent history, it still maintains considerable charm. A city tour acquaints us with some

major sights of Phnom Penh.



8am,. Visit the The private quarters of the Royal Palace are now home to the royal family and are therefore very close to the public. At the northern area of the palace grounds is Silver Pagoda, the most sacred temple in the country. Visit the National Museum where houses Khmer art, especially

sculptures from different periods of Cambodian history. We continue to one of the city's lively open markets, **Psar Toul Tom Pong**, all called the "Russian Market", where anything and everything is for

sales! Afterward, make a difference to the Cambodian community by enjoying a Khmer lunch at an NGO training restaurant.

Afternoon, Visit Toul Sleng was a high school prior to 1975, an interrogation prison known as S-21 during the Khmer Rouge era and today it as a genocide museum.

Continue to visit the **Champey Academy of Arts** (CAA), one of the local non-profit schools in Phnom Penh offering a traditional performing arts training program. Established in



January 2013 with the dea of keeping traditional performing arts alive, CAA ensure knowledge is passed down through to the next generations. The school strongly motivates students from poor and/or vulnerable conditions by giving them access to vocational training courses.

End the trip with a visit to the **Wat Phnom Temple**, **Phnom Penh's namesake**, from where you can enjoy views over the tree-lined avenues of **Phnom Penh**.

Meals included: Breakfast/Lunch





After breakfast, you'll travel by moto-rework (a *Cambodian tuktuk*) and head out of Phnom Penh on the **Japanese Friendship Bridge** before catching a ferry across the mighty **Mekong River** to **Mekong Island**. The island is famous for silk weaving, agriculture, and aquaculture (85% of residents earn their living from these industries). We'll stop to see the silk weavers at work in the village, where you can purchase some of the local products if you wish. you wander the village, you can explore a





Buddhist temple and floating fish farms, see fields of rice and morning glory, and enjoy local Khmer lunch and snacks at a family home.

Explore more villages and interact with the locals. Say goodbye to the tuk-tuk and board a boat to

enjoy the sunset from the water at the junction of the **Tonle Bassac**, **Tonle Sap**, and the mighty Mekong. You'll see the distinctive architecture of Cambodia, with Khmer-influenced buildings such as **Wat Ounalom**, the **Royal Palace**, and the **Silver Pagoda**, as well as French colonial buildings — some renovated, some ravaged by neglect and the war. Finally, we will close



off the Mekong boat tour with a gorgeous sunset. After the cruise trip, head to the riverside area of Phnom Penh, a pleasant French style promenade that is great for people viewing. From here, you can either be taken back to your hotel or left to explore this bustling area independently and have dinner at one of the many great restaurants at the riverfront (dinner will be on your own account).

Meals included: Breakfast/Lunch.

#### day 9: Phnom Penh - Sihnouk Ville Koh Rong Sonloem

08:00AM our private car and tour guide pick you up from hotels in **Phnom Penh** and transfer to **Sihanouk Ville**, it will take for 3 hours driving. Upon arrival at Sihanouk Ville, we stop to take the Jetty to the island of **Koh Rong Sanloem**.

Meals included: Breakfast

day 14: Koh Rong Sonloem - Phnom Penh

After breakfast, check-out from the resort and transfer by shuttle speedboat to the pier. Later, land transfer to **Phnom Penh** hotel for check-in (early check-in is NOT included and is at the discretion of the hotel).

### day 15: Phnom Penh - Come Back in your Country

After breakfast you will visit the city of Phnom Penh on your own. You will then be transferred to the airport for your flight back to your home or next destination.
